This means that luminaire components can also be replaced with no issues. We do not offer disposable luminaires*! This saves resources and reduces waste. With the new GreenLine product line which spans across all series we are bundling these sustainability criteria in a single label and drawing attention to particularly sustainable products from our range.

GreenLine stands for excellent sustainable products in our range. For the classification of the luminaires, we use 13 verifiable and objectively measurable sustainability criteria. They are closely aligned with the expected future European ecodesign requirements for sustainable products resulting from the Green Deal and the Taxonomy Regulation. In doing so, we always think one big step ahead. With the GreenLine products, we meet the requirements of tomorrow already today.

WE PROVIDE A FRAMEWORK FOR SUSTAINABILITY

9 basic requirements, 4 additional requirements, 1 claim

Our requirements for the GreenLine label are strict, objectively measurable and are permanently adapted to the latest developments. Only luminaires from our range that meet all criteria without restriction are awarded the GreenLine label by us.

- **1** Recycled material content \geq 50%
- 2 Modular assembly
- 3 Use of standardised Zhaga-compliant LED modules
- 4 Interchangeability of ECG and LED modules
- 5 Decomposability at the end of the service life
- 6 Recyclability \geq 80%
- 7 Upgradeability
- 8 Product guarantee at least 5 years
- 9 Spare parts availability at least 10 years

THE EU REGULATORY FRAMEWORK

The criteria set for our GreenLine label are not simply a set of good intentions. Instead, they are based on the EU's environmental and sustainability efforts, which have been given a concrete framework in the form of the Green Deal, the Taxonomy Regulation and the Ecodesign Regulation.

Green Deal:

- The EU has committed to making Europe the first climate-neutral continent by 2050.
- By 2050, there should be no more net greenhouse gas emissions in the European Union.

Taxonomy regulation:

- It is part of the Green Deal and sets binding standards for sustainable business.
- With this regulation, the EU is pursuing various environmental goals, such as more climate protection or the sustainable use of resources.

Ecodesign Regulation:

- It is a key part of the EU's efforts for greener and more recyclable products
- The regulation supports sustainability goals such as circular economy, energy efficiency and recyclability.
